Platinum Letter December 2013 Featured Mineral- Apophyllite with Stilbite

Dear Platinum-Level Members,

Our December Mineral of the Month is apophyllite-(KF) from the Mumbai District in the Deccan Traps of India. One of the world's largest volcanic formations, the Deccan Traps are also the leading source of zeolite-mineral specimens. While apophyllite-(KF) is not a zeolite mineral, it often occurs in close association with various zeolites. Some of the most attractive specimens coming out of India's Deccan Traps are composites in which apophyllite-(KF) is associated with zeolite minerals. We have specimens with and without matrix for you to choose from.

In our matrix specimens, water-clear, pseudocubic crystals of apophyllite-(KF) are intergrown with crystals of peach-colored stilbite-(Ca). These specimens have an unusual visual appeal with the excellent transparency and pseudocubic structure of the colorless apophyllite contrasting wonderfully with the bladed aggregates of translucent, peach-colored stilbite. In our matrix-free specimens, transparent, beautifully developed apophyllite-(KF) crystals stand alone in distinctive, brilliant clusters

From the hundreds of apophyllite-(KF) specimens that we had available, we have selected a limited number of exceptional pieces for our Platinum Level members and sorted them into three groups based on size, crystal development, matrix association, and overall visual appeal.

NOTE: Specimens from all three groups are available with or without the peach-colored stilbite-(Ca) matrix. Some specimens also have a dark-gray matrix of altered basalt which contrasts nicely with the bright, colorless apophyllite-(KF) crystals. Call us for a detailed description of individual specimens.

Featured Mineral Apophyllite with Stilbite



Group 1

This group includes the smaller of our special apophyllite-(KF) offerings with specimens measuring on average 3.5 inches. The colorless apophyllite shows excellent crystal development with sharp edges, complete terminations, and a bright, vitreous luster. With exceptional transparency, the interior, cleavage-plane separations appear as bright, silvery, mirror-like surfaces within the crystals. In many specimens, the apophyllite-(KF) crystals are intergrown with bladed, peach-colored crystals of stilbite-(Ca). There are also many specimens that consist solely of the apophyllite.

This group exhibits all the fine features of the previous group, but consists of larger specimens that measure four or more inches and are suitable for both detailed study and display. These larger specimens fully display the unusual brilliance and transparency of the apophyllite-(KF) crystals.

As with the other groups some of the specimens consist solely or primarily of apophyllite while others combine the peachy stilbite.
