

Citrine

Key Words – Success, warmth, comfort, abundance, healing, stability, optimism

Chakra – 1st (root), 2nd (navel) and 3rd (solar plexus), depending on the color

Element – Fire

Citrine is a form of Quartz, and the level of iron present gives it the yellow, golden, or smoky brown color. It is closely related to Amethyst, and is formed in basically the same way, hydrothermally in clefts. Much of the Citrine sold commercially today is yellow Amethyst and Smoky Quartz that have been heat treated to produce the yellow color, but in my opinion, Mother Nature does a much better job of creating a Citrine.

The name Citrine comes from the French word for lemon, "citron", since many Citrines do have that lovely, lemony yellow color. During the first and second centuries in Greece and Rome, it was used extensively as a talisman against overindulgence and treachery.

My fondest memory of Citrine is the ring my husband gave me for my birthday in October. It was absolutely perfect. We were still lying in bed, savoring the lovely morning and appreciating our time together, when he opened the drawer in the night stand next to his side of the bed and pulled out that little black box. The power of the sun is in the Citrine, and many believe it is a powerful stone to carry with them when traveling at night. It is truly a happy stone, and can bring cheerfulness and help with depression and nightmares. It can help raise energy levels and increase levels of self-confidence and self-worth.

Citrine has been called a "merchant's stone," or "abundance stone", since it is associated with the second and third chakras and abundance and good fortune. It will help one attract money and then keep it once it is acquired. It also fosters optimism, balance, initiative and personal power, and is good for new beginnings in business. Keeping one on your desk is a great idea.

Sensuality and sexuality can also be heightened by Citrine and can help relieve problems in those areas. It can help you increase your self esteem while at the same time keeping you grounded enough that you don't become arrogant.
