## Featured Mineral Clear Quartz- Rock Crystal

May 2015

Our Mineral of the Month for May is the rock-crystal variety of quartz from the classic localities in Arkansas' Ouachita Mountains. Our specimens consist of very well-developed, lustrous, terminated, hexagonal prisms of colorless, water-clear quartz. Each crystal has a distinctive, hexagonal shape with six longitudinal faces and a six-sided, pyramidal termination. Each also displays a bright, vitreous luster and crosswise, parallel striations. Although all the specimens exhibit the basic hexagonal, terminated form, subtle modifications in the crystal structure make individual specimens truly unique.

Our specimens of the rock-crystal variety of quartz from Arkansas vary primarily in overall size and in the proportions of length and width of individual crystals. Some of our prismatic quartz crystals are long and slender, while others have a more stubby shape. Each pyramidal termination is also unique in the size and angles of its six primary termination faces and also in the number and type of modifications. Making a choice of crystal shape is a matter of individual preference and your personal assessment of crystal aesthetics.

## Coming in June



The featured mineral in June will be the angelite gemstone variety of anhydrite, the anhydrous form of calcium sulfate. Unlike other forms of anhydrite, which are white or gray, the blue, massive angelite variety is fashioned into gems and decorative objects. Beads are strung into necklaces and bracelets; larger, free-form pieces are wrapped in silver wire for wear as pendants. Angelite's very fine grain enables it to take a superb polish that shows off its range of delicate blue colors. The angelite variety of anhydrite is found only in Peru.
