## Featured Mineral

Our October Mineral of the Month is agate, a form of microcrystalline quartz with a distinctive appearance characterized by translucency and multicolored patterns of bands, layers, and inclusions. Agate is an extremely popular gemstone because of its soft translucency, attractive and intricate banding patterns, and wide range of colors. Agate is usually multicolored, with several different colors appearing in each specimen.

Our specimens of cut-and-polished agate nodules, or geodes, are from Soledade in Rio Grande do Sul, Brazil, where agate has been collected for nearly two centuries. Soledade has dozens of cutting-and-polishing factories that export an estimated 3,000 tons of agate slabs, specimens, gems, and decorative items each year. Soledade, which is fittingly known as *Cidade do Pedras Preciosas* or “City of Precious Stones,” is located within a huge formation of volcanic rock that covers most of the Brazilian state of Rio Grande do Sul, along with adjacent areas of Uruguay and Argentina. When this lava solidified some 135 million years ago, gas bubbles formed cavities that later filled with silica-rich solutions and solidified into agate nodules.

All of the multicolored, cut-and-polished specimens exhibit white, blue, gray, and black colors, along with various plume, feather, and fortification patterns. These specimens are geodic and have hollow interiors lined with terminated macrocrystals of colorless, transparent quartz and occasional needle-like prisms of black goethite. The exterior of these specimens consists of a distinctive, light-brownish, celadonite crust and a “ropy” or “worm-like” texture that is a cast of the original cavity wall. Our Platinum Level agate nodules range in size from three to six inches, with the larger sizes best showing off colors, patterns, and interior crystallization. They make excellent study specimens and eye-catching display pieces.
